SUITABLE SUBSTRATES

- Sound existing finishes.
- Aluminium surfaces primed with Concept 1K Etch Primer.
- Steel surfaces.
- Polyester spray filler.
- Glass reinforced polyester.

MIXING RATIO

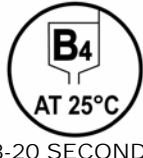


- 4 parts Concept 2K WOW Primer by volume.
- 1 part Concept Universal (MS) Hardener Fast by volume
- If needed, up to 10% reduction can be made with Concept 2K Thinner.

SPRAY GUN AND PRESSURE

SPRAY GUN & PRESSURE:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2.0mm tip with a suction feed gun Pressure is 350 – 450 kPa. (The same condition applies for gravity feed) 	
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APPLICATION

- Stir thoroughly before use.
- All surfaces must be thoroughly sanded and cleaned with Concept Wax & Grease Remover prior to application. Lightly rusted surfaces must be treated with Concept Light Rust & Metal Conditioner.
- One to two, even coats are needed to obtain a 40 - 50 Micron Dry Film Thickness.

SPRAYING VISCOSITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 18 - 20 seconds B4 cup at 25°C. 	
FLASH-OFF TIME:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 5 minutes between coats at 25°C. 	
DRYING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 15 minutes at 25°C before topcoating.
