### **PRODUCT DESCRIPTION**

This product is an acrylic based concrete coating suitable for most concrete surfaces. It provides a highly durable surface, with excellent adhesion that blocks the penetration of dirt, oil, grease, chemicals and stains, making the concrete easier to clean and maintain. It is wear resistance making it suitable for high traffic areas.

### **SUITABLE SUBSTRATES**

- Most unpainted concrete surfaces.
- Sound existing surfaces.


### **MIXING RATIO**

- Supplied ready for use. No thinning required.

### **APPLICATION**

- All surfaces must be thoroughly cleaned using a pressure clean to remove any oil and grease.
- New concrete surfaces, particularly steel towelled, must be acid washed prior to application.
- Prepainted surfaces in sound condition must be thoroughly cleaned using a pressure clean to remove any oil and grease. Any problem areas should be cleaned with Concept Wax & Grease Remover prior to application.

- Poor surfaces should be removed completely using either sandblasting or high pressure water.
- The concrete surface needs to be fully dry prior to the application of the sealer.
- Apply two even coats with either a brush or roller.
